Home Instead Senior Care, based in Charlottetown, employs professional **Care Givers**. They provide one-on-one, non-medical assistance such as light housekeeping, meal preparation, personal care, transportation, and companionship.

“At Home Instead Senior Care, we offer our Care Givers flexible hours that fit their lives and schedules,” says Charlene. “Currently there are 35 Care Givers working full-time and part-time Island-wide, plus 20 who are on stand-by for occasional shifts.

“Hiring is on-going. For every applicant, we conduct a criminal background check, reference check and drivers abstract, and conduct in-depth interviews. Of every 15 applications, about six people will be hired.

“Because the services we provide are non-medical, staff don’t need to be licensed or certified. We hire reliable, trustworthy, and dependable people. All are bonded and insured. There are no particular educational requirements, but we have our own comprehensive training program. We hire people who have the right personality and the right heart for the job.”
